


Dedicated in 1867, Cheney Hall is Connecticut's *oldest* operating theater. For the 8th consecutive year, this unique venue will host the State's most intimate indoor winter Jazz Fest experience— and your organization can be part of it!



Located at 177 Hartford Road in the Cheney Brothers National Historic Landmark District, Cheney Hall is an elegant Victorian structure. The multi-functional Hall was built as a theater and cultural community facility for the City of Manchester. The architecture is French Second Empire Style with medieval and renaissance characteristics. Features include a Mansard roof, segmented and full circle windows, brick and brownstone arches, intricate corbelled cornices, carved oak and chestnut trim in arabesque patterns and an 1866 tracker organ built into the rear stage wall.

Dedicated in 1867, Cheney Hall opened to local theatrical events, musical concerts, galas and lectures by such prominent speakers as Presidents Grover Cleveland and William H. Taft; Susan B. Anthony, and Henry Ward Beecher. In the 1970s, the Hall was threatened by demolition due to neglect, until the community created the historic district. The award-winning theater restoration was completed in 1991.

Today, Cheney Hall is the venue for the annual "East of the River" Manchester CT Jazz Fest featuring local and national jazz artists. Since 2015, we've had a wide array of renowned, world class performers, Grammy Award nominees and international jazz greats. (See page four for highlights.)
